During a recent article search under "curing" I stumbled across an article in Concrete Construction, titled "***How Much Curing is Enough?***" by Bernie Erlin. It was rather interesting article, however what was more interesting was the discovery of a great website.

www.findarticles.com, this web site allows you to search by publication, topic, or article key word. For example: if you search by Name> select letter "C" and look for *Concrete Construction*, select it. Or, you can search by Topic and select any of the pre-assigned categories, this will then list all of the publications within that category.

This will open that publication and you will see an entire web page dedicated to that specific publication. You can link to the publication web page, read the most recent issue articles or if you go to the lower portion of the page you can see all the archived issues by month and year.

You will see that some publications are free for accessing and others cost money to access. In either event, it is a great resource for finding information weather for business or personal.
